Position Summary:

The role of the Senior Software Developer is to develop and maintain new or improved software products, procedures, and techniques. This position will collaborate with Project Managers/Business Analysts to create web services and web applications that are critical to the company's growth. The Senior Software Developer will help mentor junior software developers. This position will also participate in architecture and design activities

Responsibilities:

- Optimize code design and framework
- Collaborate with Business Analysts to resolve gaps between the business requirements and design specifications
- Mentor and provide guidance to fellow software developers
- Write code that is stable, reusable, scalable and simple.
- Translate requirements to design, architect and document systems
- Participate in peer and code reviews to represent reviewed work for adherence to standards and specifications

Skills:

- Must be detail-oriented with the ability to manage multiple assignments effectively
- Ability to adhere to development standards and procedures
- Strong debugging, troubleshooting and analytical skills
- Able to work independently and efficiently to meet deadlines
- Excellent interpersonal, verbal and written communication
- Team oriented

Minimum Job Requirements:

- 3+ years of experience with HTML/ CSS / JavaScript / DOM Model.
- Extensive experience with C# / .NET / MVC / Microsoft Visual Studio
- Competent knowledge of use of frameworks and tools such as: Web API, Entity Framework, Razor.
- Sound knowledge in web development.
- Bachelor of Computer Science/Technology or equivalent work experience.
- Experience with modern JavaScript frameworks like Node.js and Angular.js a bonus
- Experience working with Scrum/Agile methodologies is preferred.

While performing the duties of this job the employee must be able to sit continuously to perform essential job functions throughout the entire shift.
